

Reading READING COMPRESSION	Record in your reading diary when you have read. Try and read 3-5 times per week. Please try to read to an adult. Adults - please use the Canine questions that will be in the home / school diary. We are focusing on a canine each week to check your child's understanding about what they have read. It is important that children read for pleasure but also that they understand what they are reading.	5-10 minutes per session	House points and reading challenge rewards.
Grammar and Spelling Spelling and Phonics	Look at the Statutory Spellings / Common Exception words sent home by your teacher - work on these at home. These will be re-tested each term. Grammar bug can also be used to support this. Check your home / school diary to see if there are any words listed in there. A classroom display has been created to aid this too!	5 minutes per session	House points given Spelling bee challenge
Targeted Homework	All extra homework is targeted according to need so if your child has struggled in a particular area they will receive targeted strengthening homework for this. Likewise, if your child needs to consolidate the learning or to deepen their understanding further. It could be maths, grammar, spelling, comprehension or even Handwriting. Please check Teams for this as an assignment will be set. This may include a teaching video attached to further support. This will also be recorded in your child's diary.	15 minutes depending on focus As necessary, Maximum one piece a day.	House points given
Online extras	TTRS / Numbots is a great resource to practice basic skills in Maths. It is expected that you child knows all times table and division facts to 12 x 12.	5 minutes	House points given Weekly certificates
