Please help your child:

Please make sure your child has their **reading diary** in school **every day**. You can help them to earn rewards by listening to them read at home too. Read **at least three times a week** and each time **sign your reading diary**. It would benefit your child to **read daily** and ask them questions about what they have read to help them progress (See canine helpers sheet). Your child will earn rewards when they have read and their reading diary is signed.

Spellings - learning year 3/4 statutory spellings and practicing them at home. (see spelling ideas sheet) Children will be able to access *Spelling Bug* on the school website to practice their spellings weekly using games etc. Spelling will be taught in school. There will be no weekly spelling test instead there will be a test of these words each half term.

PE Kits -Thursday (outdoor kit - plain, white / blue t-shirt, tracksuit and trainers), **Friday** (indoor kit -shorts and plain white / blue t-shirt) PE kits can be brought in to school at any time and left in their lockers. **Earrings are not permitted for any PE session**.
