Dear Parents,

This year, we have introduced our character pictures to our values so that our children can be even better learners. We always discuss our core values and this helps us all to think and reflect. As you know, we use our values to celebrate when children make good choices! We use stickers, badges, postcards and certificates in school for good work, behaviour and in celebration assemblies. We challenge the children to get as many of these as possible.

Each half term, the children will celebrate a value and collect house points relating to that value and any other good things they do! Once they have received 20 house points, they can come and collect a raffle ticket and a values sticker from Mr Russell. This will then be put into a box and a ticket will be drawn out each Friday for a prize!

Children get house points for:


- 1hp = Politeness / manners / behaviour / good work
- 2hp = Excellent work
- 5hp = Consistently outstanding work / Amazing display of the values
- 10hp = Special Mention Certificate / Headteacher's Award

Apart from being rewarded term on term, they will now keep a record of their development along their school journey. They will receive a book with the value statements in to keep a record of their progress from year 1 to year 6. They can get values statements signed off over the year and at the end of each half term they will have a chance of receiving one of our 6 values badges!

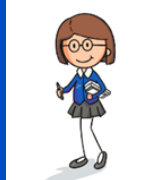
