# Ankermoor Primary Academy Behaviour policy (Appendix 1)

## Returning to school, June 2020 COVID-19

## **Expectations of parents/carers:**

- ONLY 1 Parent/Carer to bring child(ren) to school and drop off at the gate
- Young children (toddlers and babies) to stay with Parent/Carer at all times (e.g. buggy, holding hands, reigns)
- Ensure you social distance from other adults whilst waiting for gates to open

   as per government guidance (please do not arrive too early to avoid congregation)
- Parents/Carers not to enter school premises unless agreed staff on duty outside both in the morning and afternoon
- Collect your child As Soon As Possible (ASAP) if called regarding illness/symptoms
- Stick to allocated drop off/pick up times if allotted time is missed, please phone ahead but do not bring your child in until other drop offs finish-9:20am
- Parents/Carers to collect child if not adhering to NO TOUCHING rules (reminders given prior to this)

### **Expectations of children**

- Normal behaviour rules/rewards/sanctions apply 'Ankermoor Rewards and Sanctions'
- Children should stay at a social distance as much as possible (adults in school to remind children when necessary)
- Children should not play games that include touching others (e.g. tag, stuck in the mud etc...)
- Children not sticking to the NO TOUCHING rules will be reminded and parents informed to support with reinforcement
- Children to line up at a social distance in school when asked
- Children to enter the building separately and patiently
- Children to wash hands/sanitise when entering the building and at regular intervals throughout the day
- Any coughing/spitting on another pupil will result in being sent home
- Children to follow any signs and special routes in place (e.g. one way system)
- Children to avoid touching their mouth, nose and eyes and follow the 'catch it, bin it, kill it' advice
- Plastic cups will be provided for drinking no water bottles in school
- Lunches will be brought in a plastic bag to throw away after eating
- Sensible clothing and footwear to be worn depending on weather, applying sun cream before entering the setting

By sending my child back to school, I fully agree with the above expectations for everyone's safety in school.
