Dear Parents and Carers,

As we now begin to establish our recovery, it is essential that we continue to keep pupils, staff and parents safe when in school and observe the distancing requirements. **Safety is our most paramount concern at this time.**

Therefore, as part of Ankermoor's Risk Assessment, an assessment of numbers is required to ensure everybody in school is safe.

This means that the bubble spaces being used at present have a total capacity as follows:

Year group bubble	Capacity	Currently attending
Reception classroom x1	12	12
Year 1 classroom x1	12	10
Year 6 classroom x2	16	13
Yr. 2-5 keyworkers and	32	20
vulnerable classrooms x2 plus		
a 3 rd classroom when required		
Total	72	55

This means under the current assessment – the maximum number of children we can have in school with these arrangements is 72.

Be advised that on Thursday 11th June the total number of children attending was 49.

Please also be advised that when we reach the above numbers we will not be able to have any more children back in school.

Thank you for your understanding – safety is crucial at this time.
