We have been working on the story the Stickman. We went outside on a walk and collected lots of different size sticks. When we got back into the classroom we made lots of different things with our sticks. Some of us made our own Stickman and others made stick decorations and bows.

This week we have received a parcel from Santa. Inside was a letter telling us about our special delivery. It was Buddy the Elf. He now lives with us in our classroom helping us prepare for Christmas.



We have been working on our numbers to 5 in maths. We have been learning to subtilise and arrange blocks in different positions to show numbers 4 and 5. We have learnt that it does not matter where we position our blocks as the number will still represent the same.









The Year One children have been doing some fantastic sentence writing using the information we have learnt about Stickman. They were able to write sentences with capital letters, full stops and finger spaces. They also made some wonderful pieces of art-work linked to our topic 'Spirals', where they got to practise drawing a range of different spirals with different colours.
